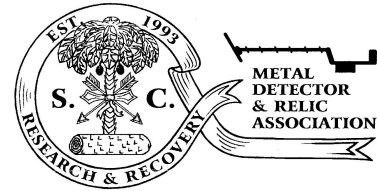

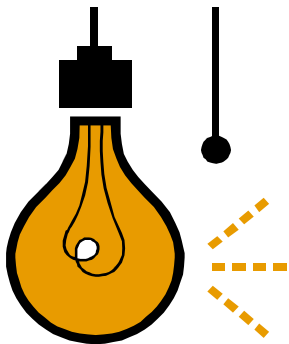

The party is set for 7 pm on Friday, December 7, 2007. Come join us for fellowship, food and the awarding of treasure hunter of the year.

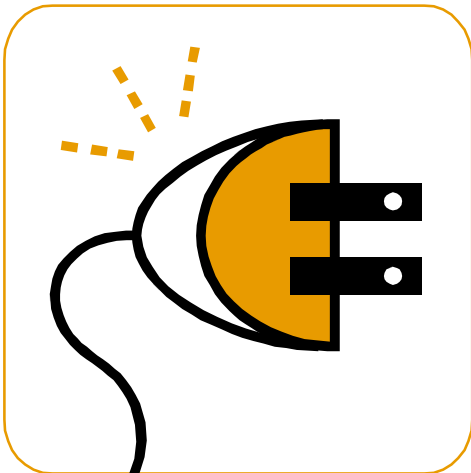
Refreshments

About Our Organization

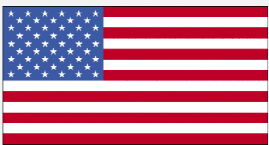
